

VISITORS RESPIRATORY ILLNESS GUIDANCE

- ✓ Wash your hands before entering and when leaving the patient room. If you are wearing gloves, you must remove them and wash your hands before leaving the room.
- ✓ Please do not wear gloves or protective gowns through the hallways.
- ✓ If you have COVID respiratory symptoms, CDC recommends you stay home and away from others.
- ✓ If you have COVID, CDC recommends you wear a mask in public for 10 days after the symptoms have started.
- ✓ If you have COVID or other respiratory symptoms, and need to visit a patient, CDC recommends you must be fever free for at least 24 hours without medications.
- ✓ Visiting a COVID patient or respiratory isolation patient? You must always wear a mask in the patient room. Please see the nurse for guidance.
- ✓ Visiting a COVID patient or you have COVID? You must remain in the patient's room. Please do not roam the hospital. Use the call bell for assistance.
