By advancing our surgical capabilities, acquiring next-generation technologies, breaking ground on new facilities, attracting top clinicians and simplifying how patients manage their care—we consistently earn national recognition. Our steady growth and transformative initiatives firmly position Jupiter Medical Center as a leader in health care excellence in the region.

This year, we achieved a major milestone with the opening of the Johnny and Terry Gray Surgical Institute, epitomizing our commitment to providing patients with the entire continuum of leading-edge surgical care. This past spring, we further enhanced our surgical capabilities, becoming one of the nation’s first facilities to acquire the da Vinci® 5 Robotic Surgical System, our sixth surgical robot. State-of-the-art investments like these address the diverse surgical needs of our patients, enabling us to deliver world-class care in an environment that fosters excellence and innovation. Such advancements not only enhance our surgical capabilities, but also attract the most skilled surgeons and clinicians, ensuring that our patients receive the highest standard of care.

As we continue to care for more patients, our facilities must also grow. Earlier this year, we broke ground on the new Patient Care Tower and Parking Pavilion. These projects will expand our capacity for inpatient care, including specialized oncology, cardiovascular, and orthopedic care, to serve our growing region. Additionally, our Neighborhood Hospital at Avenir, designed to improve access in our western communities, will open in 2026. The hospital will offer 24-hour emergency services, inpatient beds, operating rooms, a diagnostic laboratory, and imaging, giving residents access to comprehensive care close to home.

Our ongoing initiative to recruit highly skilled clinicians to our medical staff is an integral facet of our commitment to delivering exceptional care. We have created an atmosphere where clinical experts can not only practice world-class medicine, but also expand their knowledge and refine their skills. By enriching our team of experts across all specialties, we meet our community’s need for complex care.

Jupiter Medical Center empowers patients to take control of their health, which is why we recently launched MyChart®, the nation’s leading secure online patient portal. This innovative technology allows patients to communicate with their care team, schedule appointments, view test results, and manage their health from their mobile devices—ultimately improving health outcomes and the patient experience.

Our patient-centric mission and innovations are meticulously designed to support optimal outcomes, earning us several prestigious designations that underscore our commitment to quality, safety, and patient experience. We have been recognized as one of Newsweek’s World’s Best Hospitals 2024 and nationally as a Top 100 Hospital by the Leapfrog Group, reflecting the dedication of our medical staff and entire team. Jupiter Medical Center has created a culture where everyone – regardless of their role – pursues excellence. As a result, we are the only hospital in our region to achieve these designations.

ON THE HORIZON

Jupiter Medical Center has experienced extraordinary growth in recent years, solidifying our position as the leading independent, not-for-profit health system in our region. As we continue to evolve to meet the needs of our expanding community, we are excited to share some significant developments.

This year, we broke ground on a new state-of-the-art 92-bed Patient Care Tower on our main campus, representing a \$115 million investment. Scheduled for opening in 2025, this facility will enable us to better serve the increasing number of patients who depend on us for their inpatient care. To further enhance patient and family convenience, we are also constructing a five-story Parking Pavilion with 800 spaces to accommodate patients and their families.

In addition, we are thrilled to announce the development of our two-story, 53,000 sq. ft. Jupiter Medical Center Neighborhood Hospital at the Health Park at Avenir. This facility will feature 24-hour emergency services with 10 emergency room beds, 29 inpatient beds, operating rooms, a diagnostic laboratory and imaging services. This expansion will provide residents with immediate access to essential emergency and surgical care, as well as inpatient nursing and rehabilitation services—all in close proximity to home.

The new Neighborhood Hospital will also include dedicated medical office space for both primary and specialty care providers, featuring services such as:

- Primary Care (traditional and concierge)
- Specialty Care (Cardiology, Oncology, Pulmonology and more)
- Women’s Imaging
- Physical Therapy
- Phlebotomy

We are confident that these state-of-the-art facilities will enhance access to the exceptional care and high standard of service that our community has come to expect from Jupiter Medical Center.

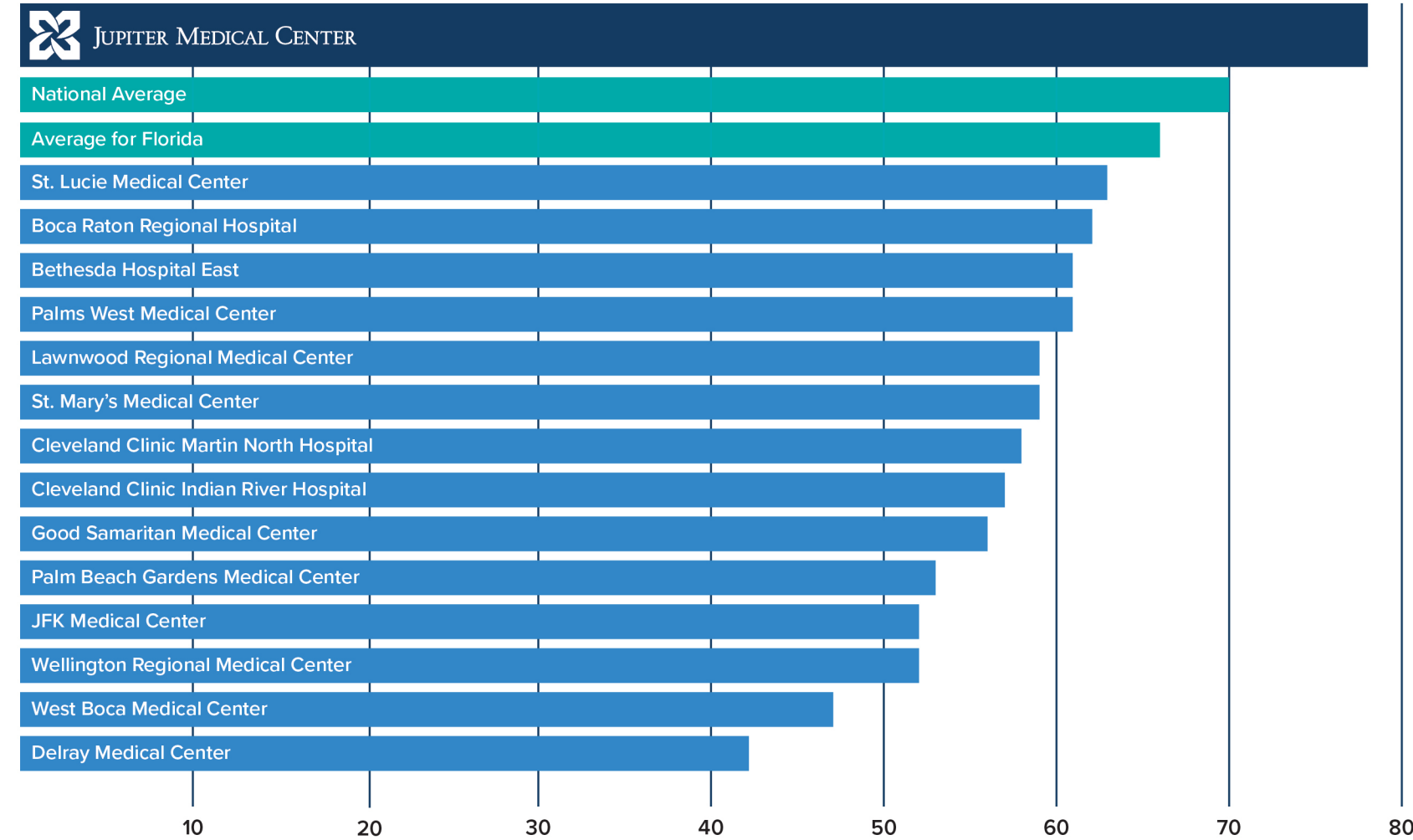

EXCEPTIONAL CANCER CARE

The Anderson Family Cancer Institute’s specialists are at the forefront of cancer diagnosis and treatment, utilizing innovative technologies and novel drug therapies, refining surgical techniques, and adopting new screening modalities. The expertise of our multidisciplinary team comprised of surgical oncologists, medical oncologists, radiation oncologists and diagnostic and interventional radiologists fuels our mission and enables us to deliver unparalleled cancer care. Comprehensive support services are provided by our dedicated team with compassion and skill.

ROBOTIC SURGERY MILESTONES

This year, we proudly became one of the first hospitals in Florida to acquire the da Vinci® 5 surgical robot—the most intelligent of the da Vinci systems. The inaugural procedure using the da Vinci 5 was performed by Dr. K. Adam Lee, Medical Director of the Thoracic Surgery and Lung Center of Excellence. Jupiter Medical Center celebrated the milestone of our 10,000th robotic procedure, along with our 200th Ion robotic-assisted bronchoscopy procedure. Our team is committed to mastering the most advanced technology to deliver unparalleled surgical care to our patients. As leaders in robotic surgery, our surgeons offer the highest standard of minimally invasive, complex cancer care.

A YEAR OF FIRSTS

Robotic surgery is one of many areas where Jupiter Medical Center embraces state-of-the-art technology. We were the first hospital in Florida to implement Patient Discovery Artificial Intelligence, helping identify signs of lung nodules on patient CT scans to aid in early detection. We were the first hospital in the region to administer a first-in-class gene therapy for bladder cancer that harnesses the body’s natural responses to target cancer cells. Our genetic counseling program was the first clinical site in the region to integrate My Gene Counsel’s Living Lab Report. The service provides updated genetic counseling information as new disease details are discovered, precision medicines are developed, guidelines evolve, and genetic variants are reclassified. All of these firsts lead to better outcomes for our patients.

NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED QUALITY

Thanks to our committed team and their dedication to innovation, Jupiter Medical Center continues to earn national recognition for cancer care. We earned *U.S. News & World Report’s* High Performing Hospital designation in 2024 for Leukemia, Lymphoma and Myeloma, Colon Cancer Surgery and Lung Cancer Surgery and were again recognized by Becker’s Healthcare as one of the nation’s top 100 oncology programs.

The National Accreditation Program for Breast Centers (NAPBC), a quality program administered by the American College of Surgeons (ACS), has once again accredited our Comprehensive Breast Care Program. Jupiter Medical Center was the first breast center in Palm Beach County and the Treasure Coast region to be accredited by the NAPBC in 2010. Our continued accreditation is emblematic of our commitment to providing best-in-class breast care in our region.

Pioneering advanced cardiovascular care: The Robson Heart & Vascular Institute sets new standards for exceptional patient outcomes.

THE POWER OF INNOVATION

At Jupiter Medical Center, our patient-centered philosophy drives us to continually adopt innovative treatments and techniques for individuals seeking advanced cardiovascular care. We offer an extensive array of robotic-assisted and minimally invasive procedures alongside newly FDA-approved implant technologies, all backed by our team’s expertise. Our general cardiologists, interventional cardiologists, electrophysiologists, and cardiac surgeons provide an unmatched level of skill and knowledge in the region.

We are proud to be the first hospital in the region to offer robotic-assisted, minimally invasive direct coronary artery bypass graft (MIDCAB) surgery. Dr. Vivek Patel, one of our highly skilled cardiovascular surgeons, performs this procedure which provides an alternative to traditional open-chest surgery. This approach results in less pain, faster recovery, and excellent outcomes. Additionally, our heart surgeons offer other advanced options, including off-pump coronary artery bypass grafting (OPCAB) and hybrid coronary revascularization.

AT THE FOREFRONT

Leading the way in cardiac care, we are often the first to introduce cutting-edge procedures. Our expertise encompasses the latest therapies, implants and devices. We are among the first in the region to provide Barostim™ Baroreflex Activation Therapy, the world’s first FDA-approved heart failure device utilizing neuromodulation to alleviate symptoms in heart failure patients.

Additionally, we were the first in Palm Beach County to adopt Boston Scientific’s AGENT drug-coated balloon for in-stent restenosis (ISR) and the first in the tri-county area to implement the Shockwave C2 Coronary Lithotripsy balloon for intra-coronary lithotripsy. For patients with atrial fibrillation (Afib) seeking alternatives to long-term anticoagulants, our electrophysiologists offer the Amplatzer Amulet LAA Occluder, which permanently closes a primary stroke pathway.

Under the leadership of cardiovascular surgeon Vivek Patel, MD, our cardiac team performed the region’s first robotic mitral valve replacement surgery. This minimally invasive procedure replaces damaged mitral valves with prosthetic

ones. We provide several minimally invasive valve replacement options, including the Edwards SAPIEN transcatheter heart valve – the first of its kind to receive FDA approval in the United States – and the Harmony™ transcatheter pulmonary valve (TPV), the first FDA-approved system explicitly designed for severe pulmonary regurgitation.

PIONEERING EXPERTISE IN ELECTROPHYSIOLOGY

Our Afib Center of Excellence offers various options to help patients manage Afib and reduce long-term reliance on blood thinners. This includes the Amplatzer Amulet LAA Occluder and the WATCHMAN™ implant. This year, our dedicated team completed its 200th minimally invasive WATCHMAN procedure. We also serve as a national teaching and training site for cardiology and electrophysiology physicians, enhancing expertise that benefits patients beyond our local community.

RECOGNIZED EXCELLENCE IN CARDIOTHORACIC CARE

The power of innovation and our position at the forefront of cardiovascular care allow our patients to access the latest, most effective treatments, resulting in improved outcomes and an enhanced quality of life. Jupiter Medical Center proudly earned “High Performing Hospital” designations from *U.S. News & World Report* for Heart Failure and Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD). These honors underscore our exceptional clinical outcomes, nursing care, and patient experience, reflecting our commitment to high-quality care.

The Anderson Family Orthopedic and Spine Center of Excellence continues to be acknowledged as an exceptional orthopedic program and is a major contributor to Jupiter Medical Center’s reputation for excellence in the region. Healthgrades recognized Jupiter Medical Center as one of America’s 100 Best Hospitals for Joint Replacement in 2025—the only hospital in Southeast Florida to achieve this distinction and one of only seven in the entire state. This designation adds to our collection of accolades that exemplify our unwavering commitment to high-quality orthopedic care.

Consistent exceptional performance has led to our continued recognition as one of Florida’s top hospitals by *U.S. News & World Report*. This prestigious designation is a result of earning “High Performing Hospital” designations in nine disciplines, including Hip Replacement. The fundamental reason for our program’s continued success is clear: We’re dedicated to leveraging cutting-edge technology to enhance patient care and outcomes.

AN INNOVATIVE KNEE-REPLACEMENT SOLUTION

We never stop looking for ways to improve our surgical capabilities and equip our talented clinicians with powerful tools, which is why we acquired the CORI™ Robotic-Assisted Surgical System in October of this year. This innovative knee replacement solution is Jupiter Medical Center’s third orthopedic robot, bolstering an already unparalleled orthopedic program that features state-of-the-art robotic solutions for a range of issues, including Mako SmartRobotics™, and the VELYS™ Robotic-assisted solution.

Smith+Nephew’s CORI technology is designed to enhance surgical precision for joint replacement surgeries. This versatile system – available for both partial and total knee replacements – facilitates real-time optimization of knee replacement surgery without the need for a preoperative CT scan, minimizing radiation exposure.

MILESTONE: 1,000 MAKO ROBOTIC-ASSISTED SURGERIES

The completion of more than 1,000 Mako robotic-arm-assisted joint replacement surgeries is another remarkable milestone for Jupiter Medical Center. We achieved this milestone due to our expert surgical team, whose dedication to mastering innovative technologies leads to reduced pain, quicker recovery, and ultimately patients returning to the things they love.

Jupiter Medical Center's compassionate stroke team provides best-in-class care for patients. Together with emergency medical services first responders, our team, led by Juan Gomez, MD, DABR, Director of Neurointerventional Radiology, combines speed with innovation and expertise to achieve the best possible outcomes for even the most complex stroke cases.

Our comprehensive approach to stroke care includes:

- **Advanced imaging including 3T MRI and CT capabilities**
- **Neurointerventional radiology expertise**
- **Rapid Response Team for early intervention and timely care**
- **Neurological Intensive Care for critical care**

We understand that exceptional stroke care extends far beyond the operating room and hospital bed. Our physical, occupational and speech-language therapists, aquatic and exercise therapy and numerous innovative rehabilitation therapies pave the way to recovery.

RECOGNITION FOR EXEMPLARY CARE

Jupiter Medical Center is proud to be the first in our region to have earned the Thrombectomy-Capable Stroke Center (TSC) certification from the Joint Commission in collaboration with the American Heart Association/American Stroke Association. This accreditation is only achieved after meeting rigorous standards for performing mechanical thrombectomy (MT) procedures and post-procedural care. We have also been recognized as a High Performing Hospital in stroke care by *U.S. News & World Report* and a 2024 Get with the Guidelines Gold Plus Hospital by the American Heart Association.

This year, the Florida Stroke Registry honored our stroke program with the "Maintaining Excellent Performance in Defect Free Stroke Care" award for 2021–2023. The award letter from the Florida Stroke Registry praised Jupiter Medical Center for our unwavering high-level performance in delivering exceptional stroke care, emphasizing that our commitment to quality improvement and excellence in patient care sets a standard for other facilities to strive for.

TRUSTED NEONATAL AND PEDIATRIC CARE

The Jupiter Medical Center team delivers neonatal intensive care in our Level II De George Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU), inpatient pediatric care at our De George Pediatric Unit, and pediatric emergency care in our Mastroianni Pediatric Emergency Department.

The De George NICU – celebrating its 5th anniversary this year – is a state-of-the-art Level II facility specially equipped to care for babies born as early as 30 weeks gestation. Our caring team of specialists provides around-the-clock care for our tiniest patients, backed by advanced monitoring and technology, with the goal of sending them home healthy and thriving.

The De George Pediatric Unit provides pediatric care for newborns up to young adults aged 18 in family-centered surroundings, featuring:

- 12 inpatient pediatric rooms
- Children’s playroom
- Bear’s Den family lounge for resting

When there’s an emergency, parents can access 24/7 emergency care from pediatric emergency specialists at the Mastroianni Pediatric Emergency Department. Whether it’s an illness or an injury, we have the right equipment – and the right clinicians – to meet kids’ unique care needs at any age.

For issues that don’t warrant an emergency room visit, we have urgent care centers to help meet family medical needs. Our conveniently located centers treat pediatric patients with minor emergencies, injuries and illnesses. They also offer flu shots, lab services, onsite x-rays, preoperative testing, and school and sports physicals.

Jupiter Medical Center has been certified by the National Safe Sleep Hospital Certification Program in recognition of our commitment to implementing best practices for mothers and their babies during their hospital stay, as well as our efforts to educate families on safe infant sleep at home. Our Safe Sleep initiative provides ongoing education and support for new parents with infants up to one year of age. MEETING A GROWING NEED FOR UROLOGY CARE

A substantial gift from Barb and Joe Charles has created the Barb and Joe Charles Center for Urology in the Anderson Family Cancer Institute on the hospital's main campus, which opened in June of 2024. Research has shown that there is a growing demand for access to specialized and emerging treatments for urological conditions, which is why creating a dedicated urological care center has been a priority.

The center operates on a multidisciplinary model so patients can receive the best quality care in an environment that prioritizes personalized treatment and superior outcomes. A NEW CENTER FOR CARDIAC ELECTROPHYSIOLOGY

Hugh, Nancy and Chad Elliot committed \$10 million to Jupiter Medical Center to support a project close to their heart: to establish the Elliot Family Center for Cardiac Electrophysiology.

SUPPORT FOR EMERGENCY ROOM FAST TRACK SUITES

A gift from Peter and Missy Crisp will support our Fast Track Suites in the newly expanded and modernized Petrocelli Emergency Center. The Fast Track Suites house 8 Fast Track bays, which expand our emergency care capacity and enable a dual-track system where patients are triaged to separate those with acute care needs, such as stroke, heart attack, major injury or trauma from those with lower-acuity needs or minor ailments.

The availability of Fast Track Suites allows our emergency medicine providers to rapidly assess critical patients for immediate treatment.

DECADES OF PROFOUND SUPPORT

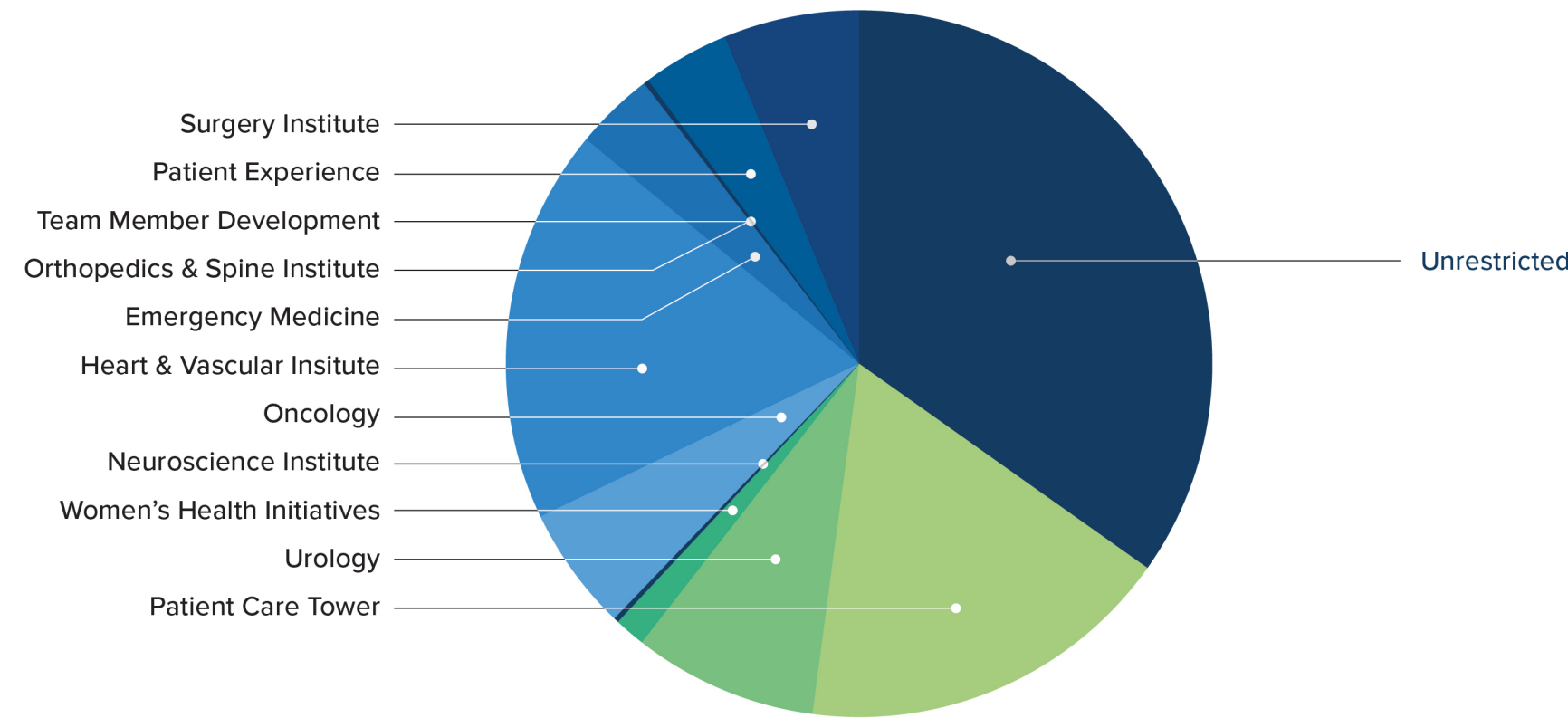

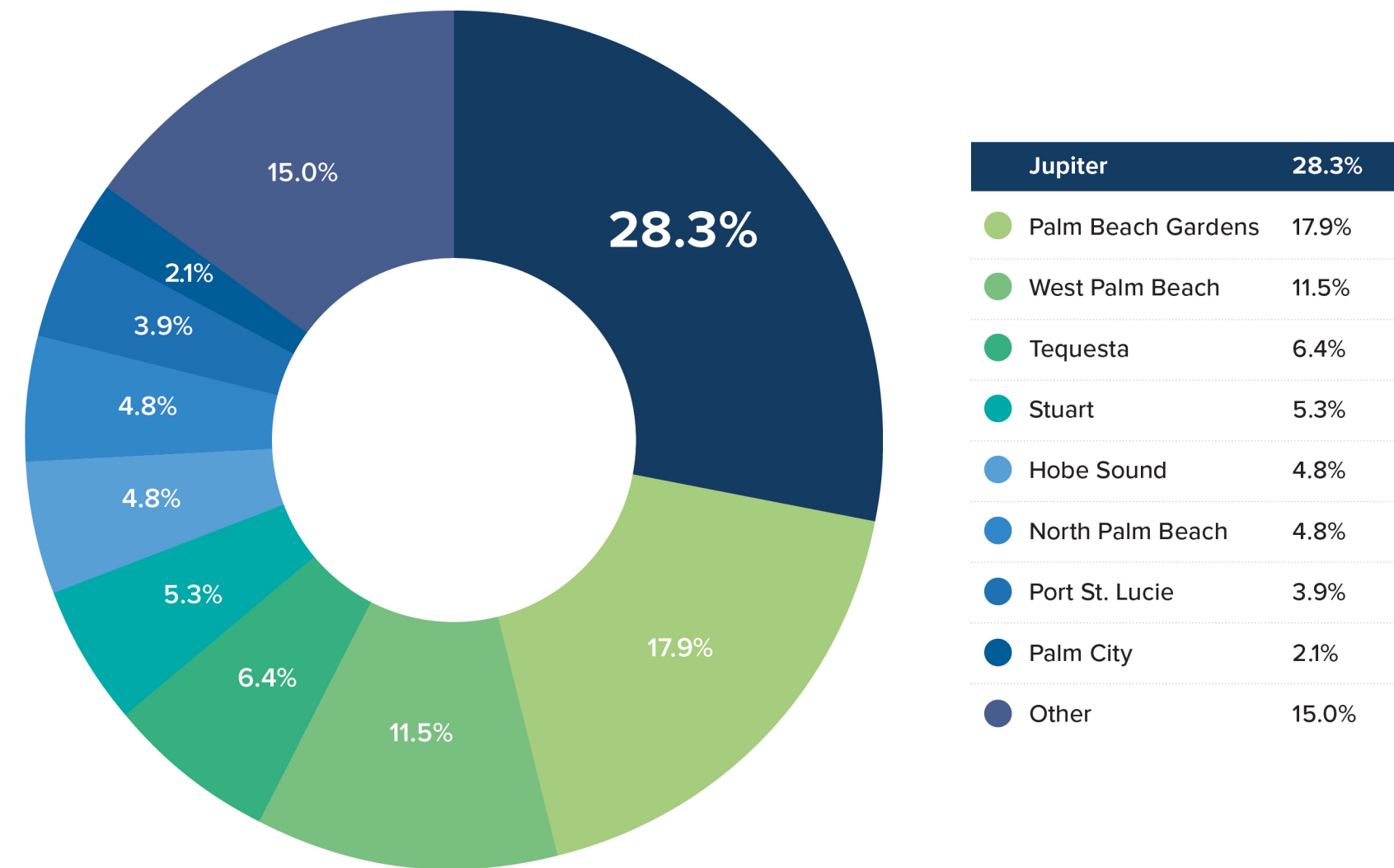
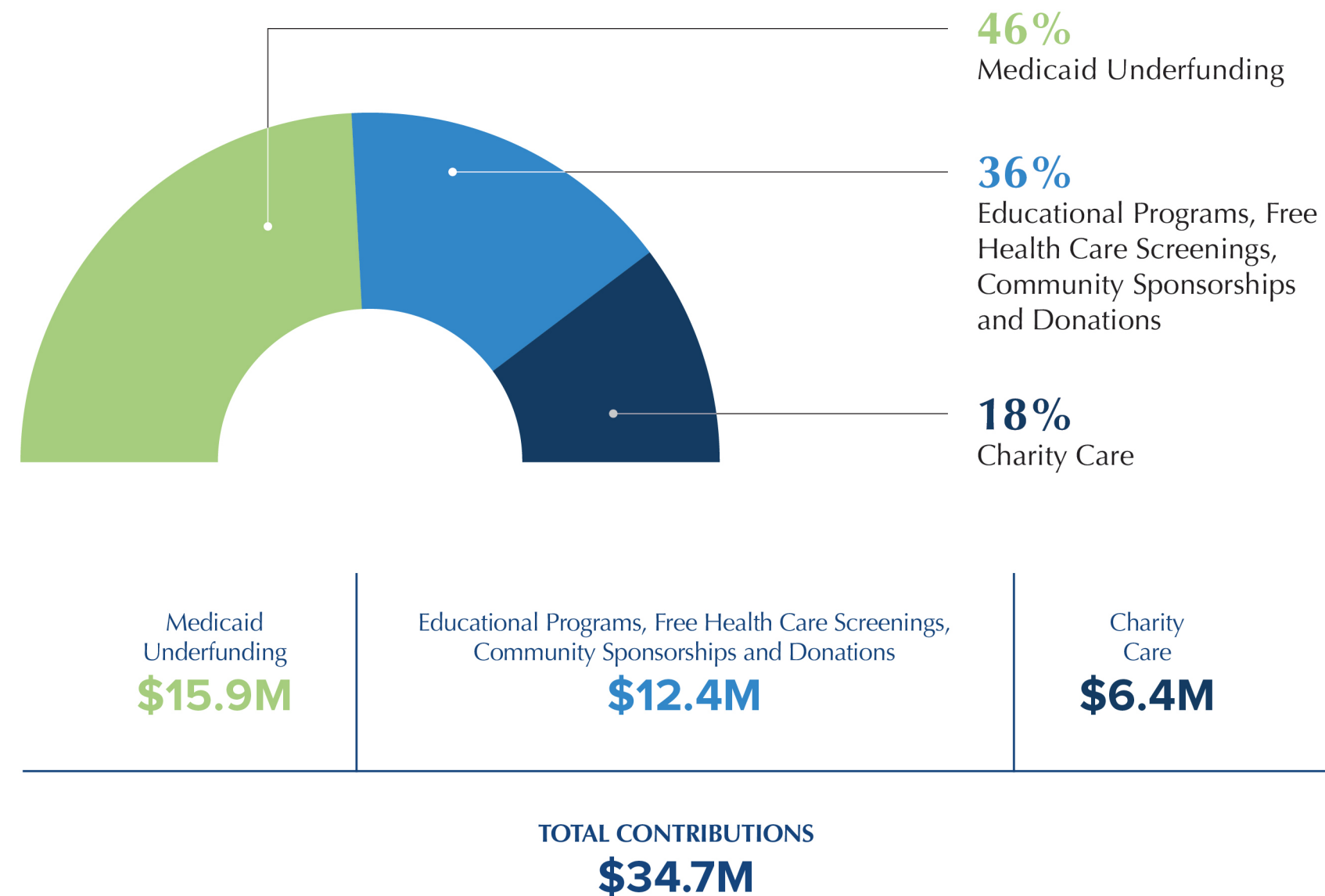
Fiscal Year 2024 Contributions by Service Line

Community Benefit by Category



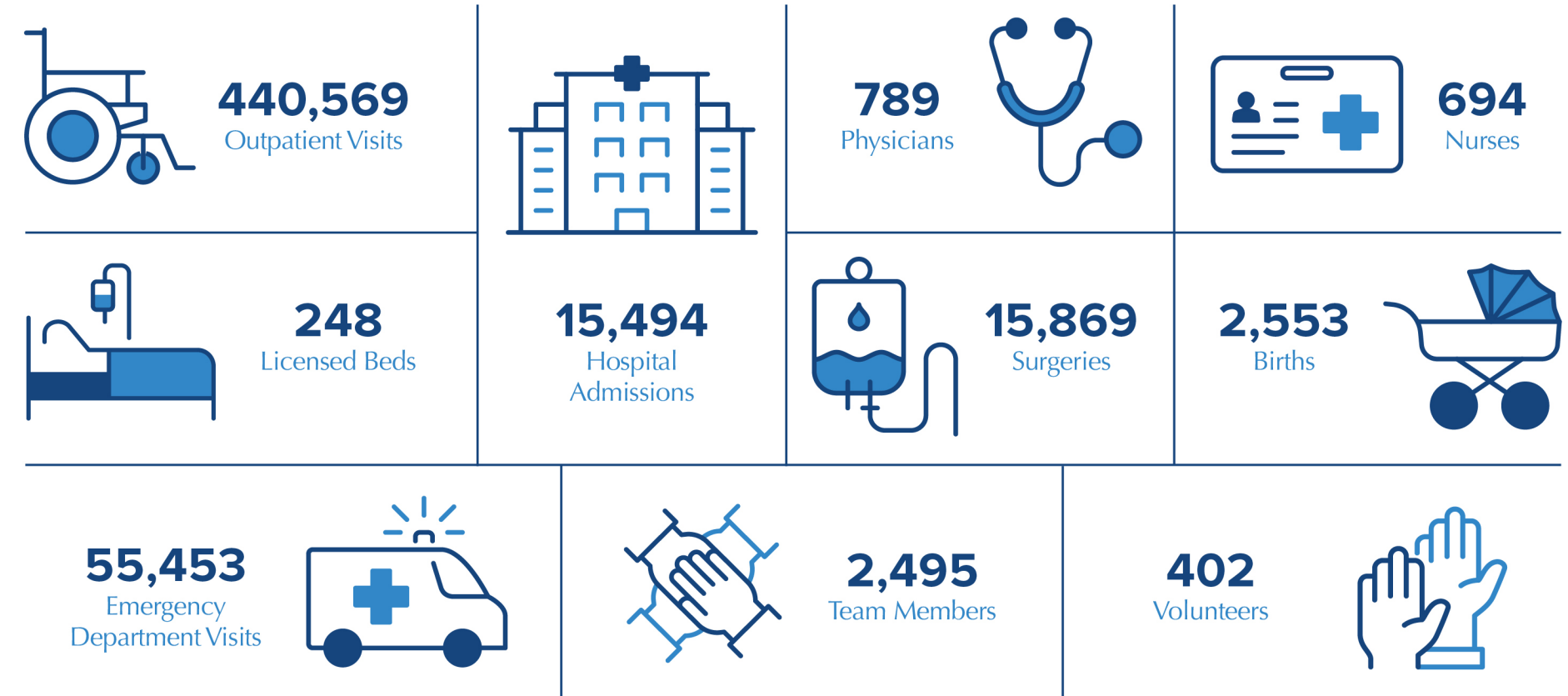
